Request for Refund of Property Tax:

Ms. Schnyer moved to approve tax refund of \$369.88 to Marjorie Fletcher. Mr. Truskauskas seconded. All were in favor.

Fair Housing Resolution:

April is Fair Housing month and the Town is updating its Fair Housing documents. The Fair Housing resolution affords all persons a right to full and equal housing opportunities in the neighborhood of their choice. Mr. Truskauskas moved to approve the Fair Housing Resolution. Ms. Schyner seconded. All were in favor.

Board of Finance Request for an RFP for sale of Community Hall:

The Board of Finance sent a formal request to the Board of Selectmen for an RFP for the sale of Community Hall. Currently, the building costs the Town \$10,000 per year. The RFP would not be geared toward an outright sale, but more for a 501C organization in the community, or a long term sublet agreement. Mr. Truskauskas moved to draft an RFP for the Board of Finance. Ms. Schnyer seconded. All were in favor.

First Selectman's Report

The Board of Finance has set the budget number at \$5,416,323 which is 2.2% lower than previous year. The Town had substantial savings in health care, pension, and several renegotiated vendor contracts. The town's portion of the school budget increase is .89% or approximately \$90,000. The mill rate will be set after the Annual

Town Budget Meeting in May. A school budget referendum will be held on Tuesday, May $5^{\rm th}$ 2015.
