1. Annual Report for the Town

2. Historic District Outreach Project

No further work has been done on the project. A motion was made by Greg to table this item until January 2015; seconded by Peter. All in favor.

3. Other Business

Carole reported on a few items:

- Some repair work has been done, but not completed as of this date, on the South Road Cemetery's stonewalls by volunteer stonemason Mike Angelicola.
- Town Historian Roger Plaskett has started discussing plans with the Historical Society and the Hungerford Museum for hosting a graveyard tour of the South Road Cemetery next October, with some members possibly dressing up and portraying in period costume some of the notable citizens who are buried there and giving a narrative about them.
- There was some discussion of the Commission's budget for 2014-15, which is \$1,672.

4. Next Meeting

The next two meeting dates were discussed. Due to the upcoming holidays the members agreed to cancel the November 18th and December 16th meetings unless there is a request from one of the Historic District property owners for starting the process for a Certificate of Appropriateness.
