**Meeting called to order** at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman, Michael Flowers.

**Minutes** of the February meeting were accepted on a motion by Bruce Wilcox, second by Wayne Delmonte, so moved.

**A presentation** was made by Mike Truskauskas for his Eagle Scout Project. He would like the Recreation Commission to approve construction of 5 boardwalks, ranging in length from 13'-33', at the Conservation/Recreation Area. Motion by Steve Graboski, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bruce Wilcox to approve the proposed improvements to the Conservation/Recreation Area as outlined by Mike Truskauskas for his Eagle Scout Project. So moved.

**Director Report:** The spring and summer program schedule is set. Additional programs may still be added.

The possibility of a fencing program for middle school age kids is being researched.

Members were reminded that volunteers are needed on 5/11 for the Hershey Track & Field Games.

We are moving forward with sponsorship of the Harwinton Vipers Baseball team, which will play in the Senior Division of the Jaycee/TD Bank League. Thank you to Darren Brown for his help with this new project.

Copies of the budget request for FY 2011-2012 that has been approved by the Board of Finance were distributed.

Suzanne has contacted the Town's insurer for information regarding pick-up play at the Sports Complex.

Sabrina has contacted the local Dunkin Donuts to see if they are interested in sponsoring a summer outdoor concert.

**Chairman Report:** None

**HYSA Report:** HYSA will be hosting the CT State District Little League Tournament at the Harwinton Sports Complex in July.

Field day 'clean-up' is scheduled for 4/10. The tentative calendar, subject to field conditions, is as follows: start practices on 4/11, first games on 4/25, and opening day ceremony on 4/30. During the season some games will be scheduled with Plymouth, Burlington and Torrington.

HYSA now requires at least 1 coach for every team to take an on-line concussion clinic.

**Other Business:** Dogs and irresponsible dog owners are still causing problems at the Conservation/Recreation Area. Owners are not leashing their dogs or cleaning up after them.

The Highway Department plans to move the light on the flagpole at the Sports Complex.
