

**TOWN OF HARWINTON
ORDINANCE REGULATING PRIVATE SNOW REMOVAL**

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of §§ 7-148(c)(6)(C)(v) and 7-163a of the General Statutes of the State of Connecticut, Revised to 1997, as amended, the Town of Harwinton hereby adopts the following ordinance regulating private snow removal.

Section 2. For purposes of this ordinance, the terms "highway" and "street" shall have the same definition as set forth in § 13a-1 of the General Statutes, as amended. The term "shoulder" shall mean that portion of the highway between the boundaries of the highway and the paved or traveled portion of the highway. The term "sidewalk" shall mean that area adjacent to the highway or street intended for pedestrian use.

Section 3. No person shall plow or throw or cause to be plowed or thrown any snow or ice from any premises, on or into any state or municipal highway, street, shoulder or sidewalk in the Town of Harwinton, in such manner as to cause inconvenience or hazard to public travel.

Section 4. Any person who violates this ordinance shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be fined FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) for each violation.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in a newspaper having circulation in the Town of Harwinton.
