# 5. Sewer Use Rules & Regulations.

Chairman Criss reports that Atty. Michael Rybak will be reviewing the draft with him on February 9<sup>th</sup>. Further discussion is tabled to the next WPCA meeting (3/8/11).

Members discussed possibly including additional correspondence with sewer user bills which would illustrate how the WPCA is keeping costs down and perhaps offer homeowner sewer line insurance. This type of insurance has been used in the city of New Britain. Mr. Bonola plans to bring information regarding this to the next meeting.
