Chairman Criss reads aloud copy of letter to Targa I, dated 7/25/11, with bill attached from Torrington for Emergency service call on July 1, 2011, to sewer main back-up within Sunset Ridge development on Ross Road. There is some discussion as to what could have caused the plug/clog leading to build-up of sewage in the main line.
