OPEN HEARING – ESTABLISH QUORUM.

Chairman T. Rotondo called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All regular members present are seated. LUC Redmond reads the call to hearing as published in the Republican American newspaper on 4/9/21 and 4/18/21. Proof of certified mailings giving notice of this hearing to neighbors within 200 feet of the property lines have been received and remain on file.

2. EDGAR ROSADO – APPLICATION FOR A 10-FOOT NORTH SIDE YARD VARIANCE FROM SECTION 5 ZONING REGULATIONS, DATED 10/29/18, FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A 15' X 30' ABOVE GROUND POOL, 160 WILDCAT HILL ROAD (CR ZONE).

Mr. & Mrs. Rosado are present for the virtual meeting. Mr. Rosado explains to the Commission the requirement of Torrington Area Health District to remain 20 feet from the leaching fields and a curtain drain located in the rear of the property instead of the normal 10 feet. P. Brazaitis IV questions whether the 15 foot width is horizontally off set from the side property line with Mr. Rosado replying that it is the 30 foot length of the pool that runs horizontally with the property line and that if the pool were turned it would be too close the leaching fields.

Chairman Rotondo opens the floor for public comment to which there is none.

T. Root, Jr. **motioned** to close the hearing at 7:18 p.m., seconded by T. Barry. Motion passed unanimously.

 - P. Brazaitis IV states that above ground pools are not truly permanent structures as they do not last a lifetime. M. Durstin believes this to be a legitimate hardship with regards to the septic system location

and the property line configuration. M. Durstin motioned to grant the variance with the hardship being configuration and location of septic system and the requirements of the Torrington Area Health District. T. Root, Jr. seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
