

HPL Building Committee Minutes
April 25, 2016 Harwinton Public Library

Meeting called to order at 7:07

Motion to approve minutes from 4/11 by Lisa. Second by Barbara. Unanimous.

Progress of Project

- Committee reviewed development of plans:
 - Ken discussed progress of site plans by Milone & MacBroom Engineering- (drainage, septic, wheel stops, accessibility) drainage in parking lot draining to the east into rain garden(s). It was suggested that gutters to new addition drain underground while those on existing building will drain onto ground. Drainage changes eliminated need for retaining wall by children's area, which will be regraded, instead. Milone & MacBroom are finalizing their work for presentation to the town.
 - Committee looked at samples of brick that closely match the existing building.
 - Ken and Michael presented lighting samples for each of the spaces. All are LED, which are highly efficient and long lasting. All will be able to be individually adjusted from staff area.
 - curvy bars leading into children's area with flush bars in adult, children's, stack and front staff areas
 - community room will have flush lighting divided into 4 areas which can be dimmed individually
 - 2 circular bars in storytelling area
 - 2 colored rings in children's area to either side of bump out
 - high ceiling areas, gallery corridor, business area, main entrance, conference rooms will have narrow suspended LED strips with up light / down light
 - Friends area, break room, chair storage will have 2' x 2' flush fixtures similar in appearance to florescent
 - drum lighting in periodical and computer areas
 - study areas will have 4' x 4' flush LED lights
 - bathrooms will have uplight / downlight with warm/cool light option
 - outdoor lights to match the rest of the complex and round LED's along outside of building
 - Committee looked at flooring samples and leaned toward commercial carpets and LVT tile in neutral mixed greys/taupe tones
