Librarian's Report: Highlights include:

- MARC records uploaded to the FindIT server
- There has been some improvement in delivery of books by C-car. It still takes up to 2-3
 weeks to retrieve a book
- Civic Family Services grant is being used for the annual subscription to 'Artist Works for Libraries'
- Connecticut State Grant 0187 this year has been applied to Ancestry.com
- Mike Cris wants to hook the library up to the town generator
- The library needs to appear in front of the Zoning Commission to discuss the addition plans
- There is a quote from TLC for a \$9000 server. The old server is beyond its life and will no longer be supported by TLC. We have 2 options:
 - 1. Remote hosting of the card catalog more expensive
 - 2. Local hosting of the card catalog lower cost and we keep control of our records

The server cost has been discussed at the Town Hall but not formally submitted Motion by Barbara to authorize the expenditure of \$9000 for a server, approved.

- Tax prep project went well.
 - AARP has set a goal of 100 tax preparations at our facility for 2017.
- Library Plant Book and Bake Sale is scheduled for 5-21-2016
