ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THREE (3) ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION

Be It Ordained and Enacted by the Town of Harwinton:

Pursuant to the authority granted by Chapter 126 of the General Statutes of the State of Connecticut, 1958 revision, as amended, the Town of Harwinton hereby establishes the following provisions for the appointment of three (3) alternate members to the Town of Harwinton Planning Commission, who shall serve and have such powers and duties as set forth in the General Statutes, Chapter 126.

SECTION ONE. Within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this ordinance, the Board of Selectmen shall appoint three (3) alternate members to the Planning Commission, one of whom shall hold office until the 30th day of November, 1972, one of whom shall hold office until the 30th day of November, 1973, and one of whom shall hold office until the 30th day of November, 1974. Following the Tuesday after the first Monday of November, 1972 and prior to December 1, 1972, and annually thereafter, the Board of Selectmen shall appoint one alternate member to the Planning Commission to hold office for a term of three years from November 30th of the year of his appointment.

SECTION TWO. Any alternate member of the Commission who is absent from three consecutive regular meetings and any intervening duly called special meetings shall be considered to have resigned from the commission and the vacancy shall be filled as provided by Chapter 126 of the General Statutes, 1958 Revision as amended, except that the regular members of the Commission may vote to waive the requirements of this section in each case where illness or other extenuating circumstances make it impossible for an alternate member to meet the attendance requirements of this section.

SECTION THREE. This ordinance is to take effect at the time provided for by section 7-157b of the General Statutes.
