

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING LICENSING OF PEDDLERS

BE IT ENACTED by The Town of Harwinton in Town Meeting:

Section 1: No person, firm or corporation shall sell, offer for sale, vend, hawk, peddle or barter, or assist in selling, offering for sale, vending, hawking, peddling or bartering, upon the streets, sidewalks, public places, or from house to house, at public or private sale, or at auction, in the Town of Harwinton any goods, wares or other merchandise unless he has obtained a license to do so from the Town Clerk.

This section shall not apply to those persons exempted by the provisions of Section 21-37, General Statutes, Connecticut, 1958.

Section 2: The Town Clerk shall issue the license required by the preceding section upon application therefor in writing and upon payment of a license fee of Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00); said license shall be valid for one year from the date of issue thereof and shall not be transferable.

Section 3: Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not more than Fifty dollars (\$50.00) and each sale made without such license shall constitute a separate offense.
