

## ORDINANCE ADOPTING REGIONAL PLANNING

### Sec. 1

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 127 of the General Statutes, Connecticut, The Town of Harwinton hereby adopts the provisions of said Chapter and elects to participate in the regional planning agency now or henceforth existing under authority of said chapter in the Torrington-Winchester Planning Region, as defined by the Connecticut Development Commission pursuant to the provisions of said Chapter.

### Sec. 2

The Town of Harwinton having a population of 3344, according to the federal census of 1960, shall have two representatives of the agency. The Board of Selectmen shall appoint one member to the agency who shall be an elector of the Town and who shall serve an initial term of one year. Thereafter, all appointees shall serve two years. The planning commission of the Town of Harwinton, duly constituted, shall appoint one elector to the agency for a term of two years. Appointees shall serve for the term of their office and until their successors shall have been appointed. Appointees may be reappointed. Terms of office shall commence when the appointment is made or from the first organization meeting of the agency, which ever is later.

### Sec. 3

#### Resignation of Member

Vacancies created by resignation or inability to serve shall be filled by the authority which originally appointed the member who filled the office before the vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired term. Any representative who is absent from three consecutive regular meetings of the regional planning agency and any intervening duly called special meetings thereof shall be considered to have resigned from said body, except that the requirement of this section may be waived by the appointing authority for good cause.
