

ORDINANCE CONCERNING NEEDS OF AGING

ORDAINED BY THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF HARWINTON:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted in Section 7-127a and 7-127b of General Statutes, there is hereby established a committee on needs of the aging to be known as the Commission on Aging.

Section 2. The Commission on Aging shall consist of five members and an ex-officio member who shall be appointed by The Board of Selectmen. On or before the third Monday of November 1975, the Selectmen shall appoint two electors of the Town to serve for a term of three years, two electors of the Town to serve for a term of two years, and one elector of the Town to serve for a term of one year from said date, and the Selectmen shall on or before the third Monday of November of each year thereafter appoint members to fill the offices of those whose terms are expiring in that year to hold office for terms of three years from the third Monday of November of the year of appointment.

Section 3. On or before the third Monday of November of each year, the First Selectman shall appoint a municipal agent to provide information to the elderly who shall be charged with the duties set forth in Section 7-127b General Statutes and such other duties as the Commission shall prescribe. Said agent shall be an ex-officio member of the Commission.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective fifteen (15) days after a publication in a newspaper having circulation in the Town of Harwinton in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes.
